

Examples of Phytosanitary Certificates issued by the UK

Dear Colleagues,

The model templates for the phytosanitary certificates issued by England and Wales, Scotland, The Isle of Man and Guernsey published on the IPP portal have been updated, please see [Latest Publications - International Plant Protection Convention](#). These revised certificates will be effective from 12 May 2026.

The changes to the certificates are:

- England and Wales - 'reforwarding phytosanitary certificate' has been amended to England and Wales 'phytosanitary certificate for re-export' in section 2.
- England and Wales – the Defra logo has been updated to reflect the current departmental logo.
- Scotland - 'reforwarding phytosanitary certificate' has been amended to Scotland 'phytosanitary certificate for re-export' in section 2.
- Isle of Man - 'reforwarding phytosanitary certificate' has been amended to Isle of Man 'phytosanitary certificate for re-export' In section 2.
- The other example certificates are unchanged.

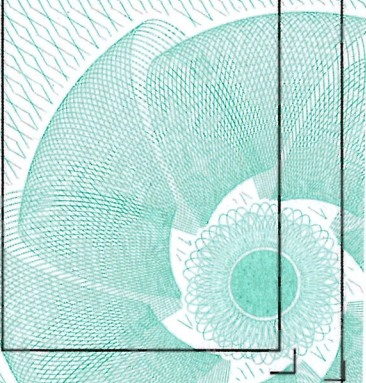
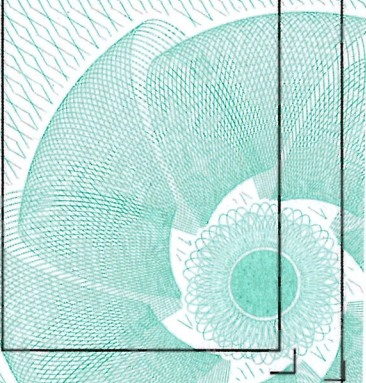
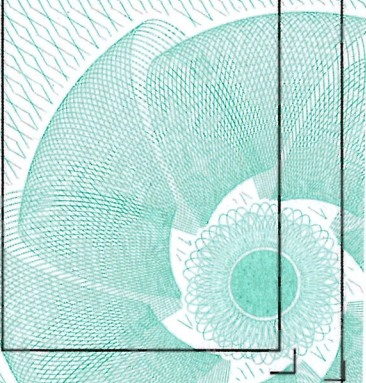
